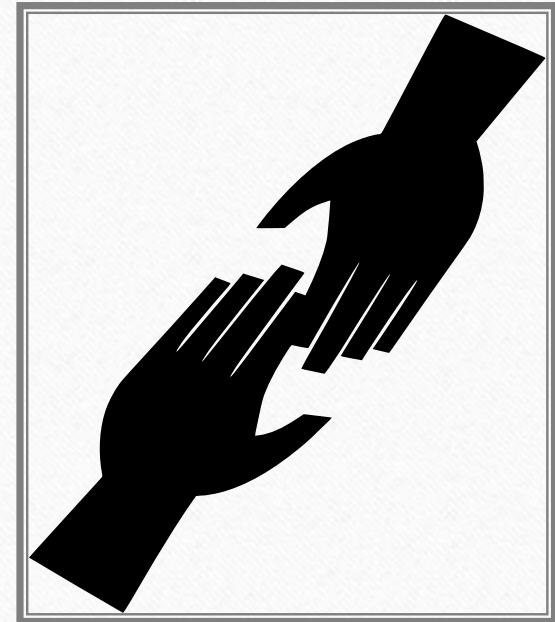
- All students are provided with a Chromebook to use inside of the building, these stay at school

Non-COVID Health Policies

- Student with a temperature
